

**APPLICATION
For Septic System Assistance
Lower Nueces River Watershed**

The Nueces River Authority has received grant funding through the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to implement a bacteria reduction program designed to provide financial assistance to eligible property owners to repair or replace existing septic systems which are not functioning properly.

An improperly functioning septic system may release bacteria into ground and surface water causing bacterial contamination and possible illnesses to both humans and animals.

This program is offering, free of charge to the property owner on a first-come first-serve basis, septic system pump outs and inspections, and repairs and/or replacements recommended by the septic inspectors. The program is open to homeowners within the Lower Nueces River Watershed (between Lake Corpus Christi and the Saltwater Barrier Dam in Calallen).

With your permission, a certified On-Site Septic Facility (OSSF) inspector will evaluate your septic system. Where inspections find septic system malfunctions, the information will be used only within the assistance program and is not referred for enforcement purposes.

I grant permission for a certified OSSF inspector to conduct an evaluation of my septic system. I understand that there are risks, such as additional damage, associated with pumping out and inspecting a degraded system. If my system is in need of repair or replacement, I will have a quote approved by the Nueces River Authority before the work is completed. I will also sign an agreement to maintain the system that received assistance under this program.
